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# Who Was Invited to participate in the First Quarter Survey

Roughly 825 out of 1000 members were invited via email to participate.

There are approximately 175 members whose personal email we currently do not have.

Also members that did not provide their E.I.N. could not participate due to our inability to positively identify them.

# Who actually did participate in the first semester?

192 verified members participated

23.4% of emailed members or roughly 20% of all members.
